The reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation, and First Eucharist may occur after a child reaches the age of discretion (7 years old) and has received the proper catechetical instruction. (see Canon Laws 97, 777, 889-91, 913-14, & 989)

The All Saints Catholic Community has adopted a Sacramental Preparation Readiness Program to assist children and families in preparing for the sacraments. While designed as a three-year program at its core, the child is able to move through the program at his/her own pace. A mentor, is assigned to each family guide and pray for the child and family.
